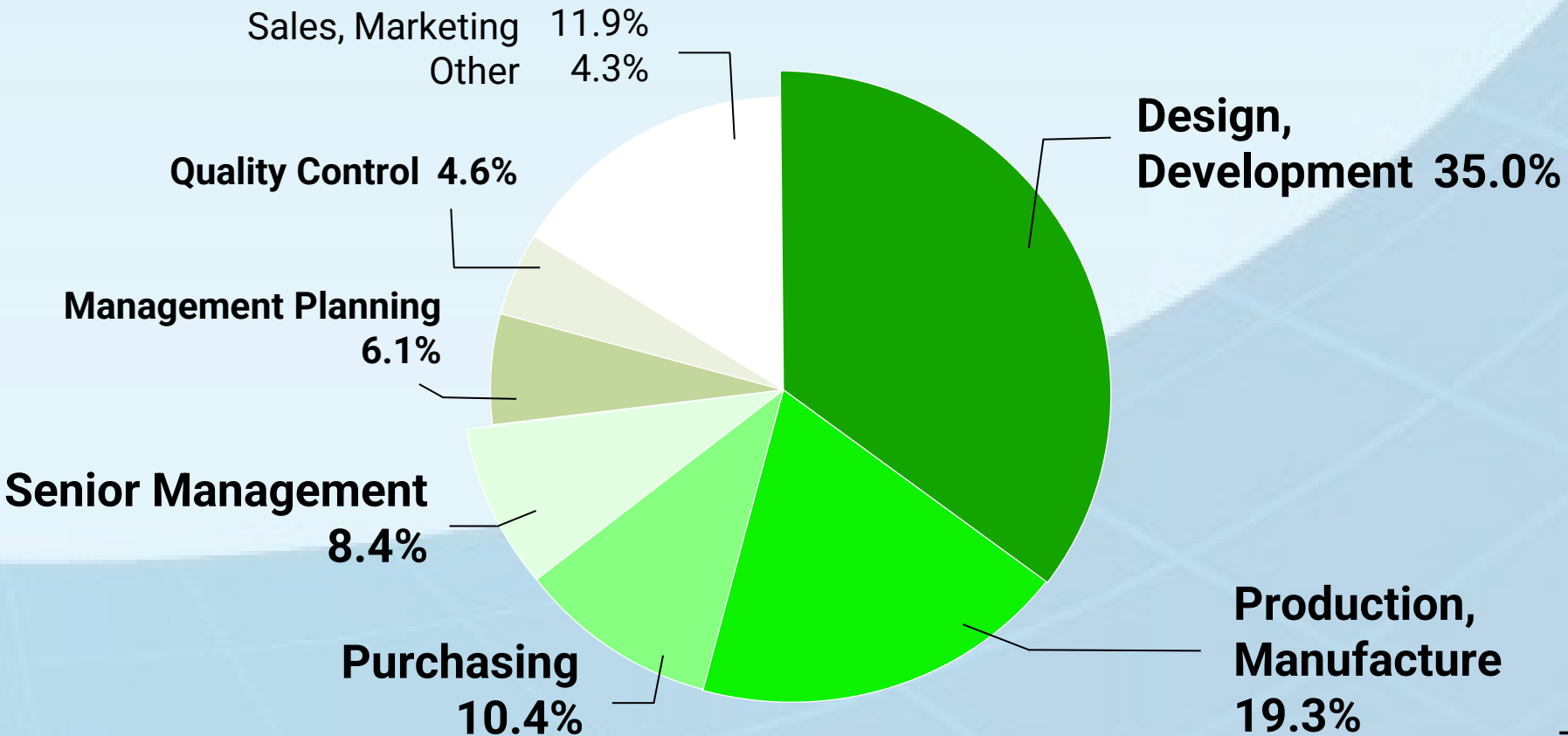
## Primary Business

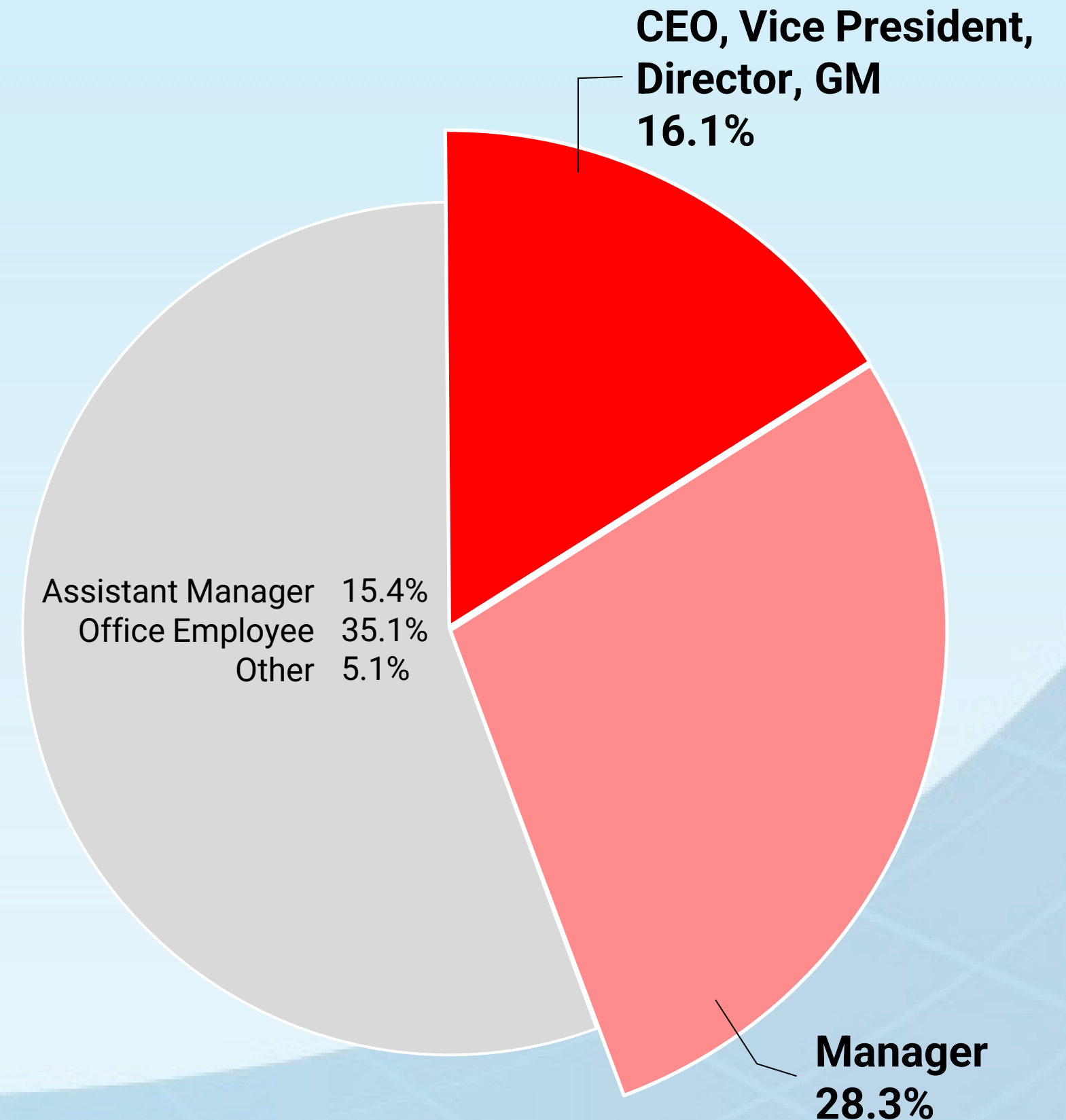

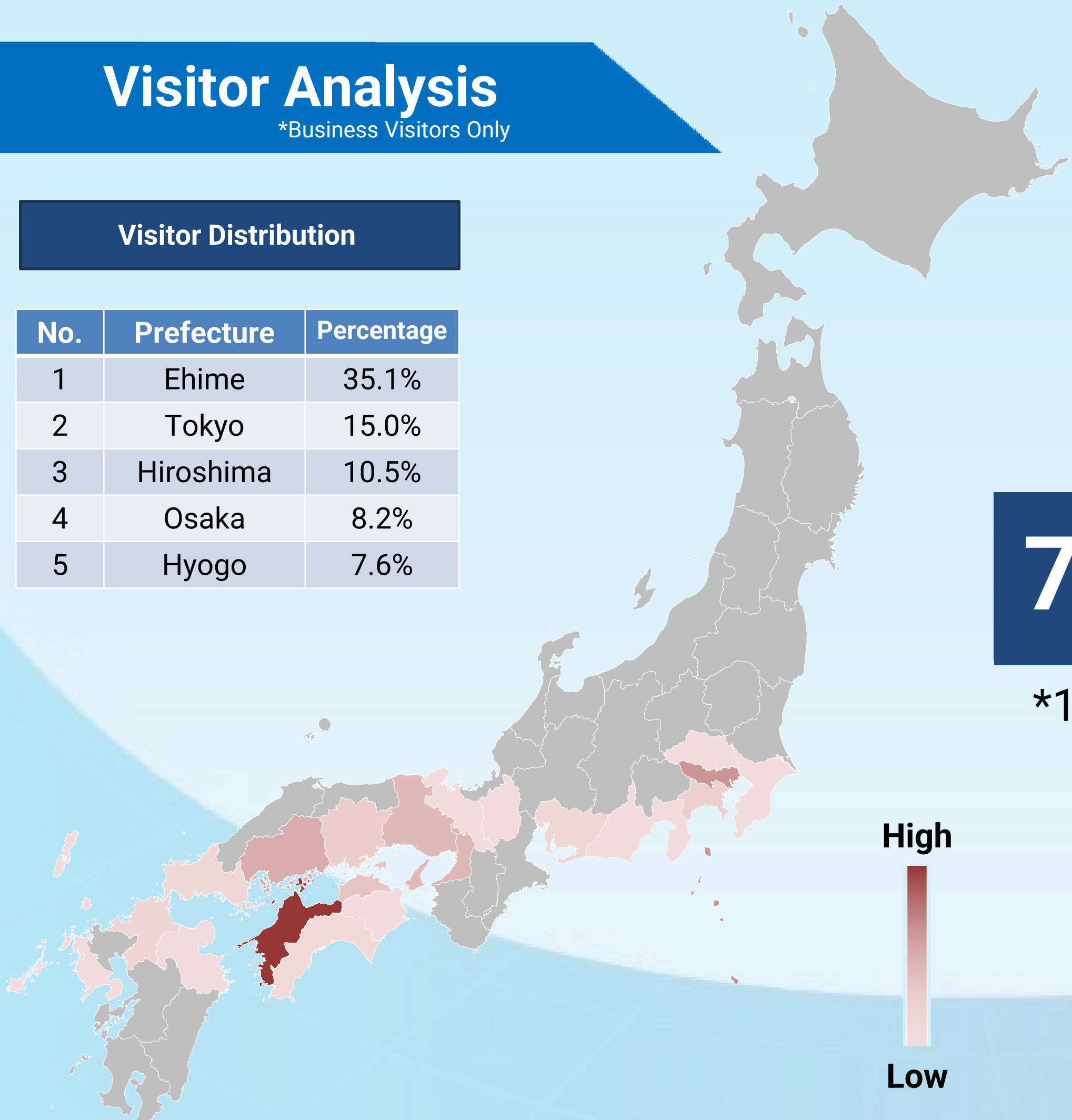

The event provided an excellent business opportunity and a chance to discover new business partners. I look forward to actively participating in future editions.



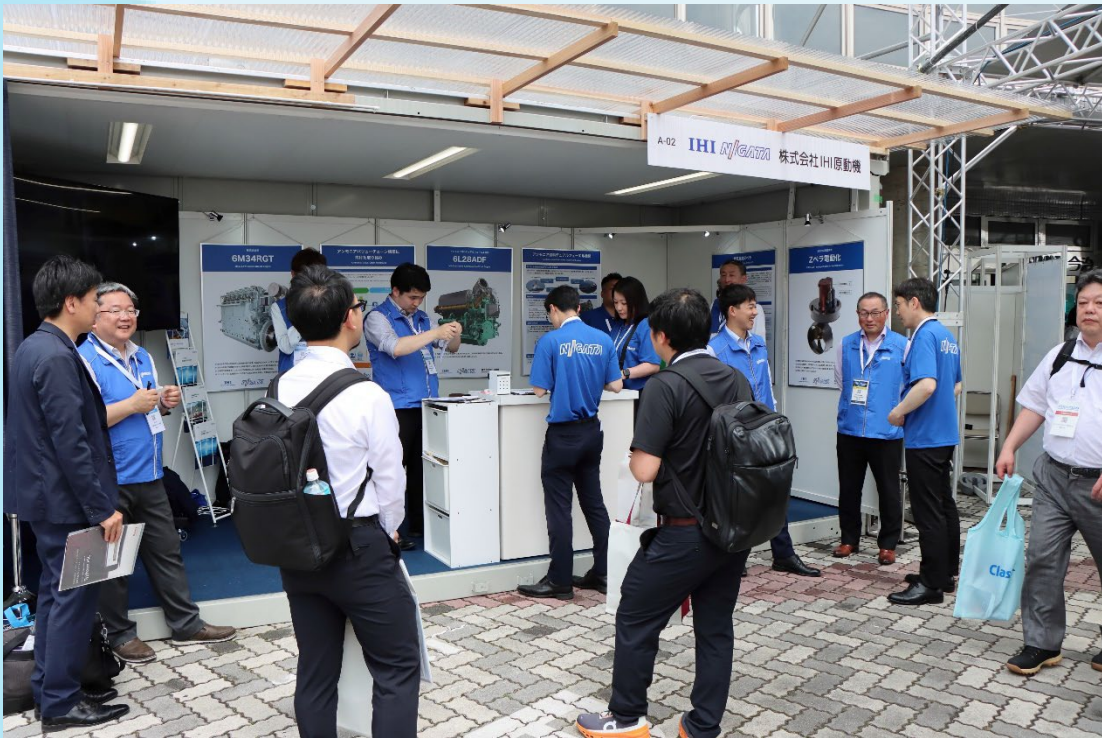
